

1. Lobby and advocate for accesses to justice, for abused children and adolescent.
2. Protection of teenage girls against domestic abuse, trafficking and early pregnancies
3. Empowerment of youth to participate in building societies and achieve prosperity and self independence
4. Inclusive communities, education and the right for protection and inclusion for disabled children and adolescent
5. Inclusive societies and the rights for capacity building and employment for youth and disabled youth
6. Gender equalities and impartiality
7. Promote and emphasize the needs for universal rights and lobby for the integration of inter ethnic and religious minorities, primarily children, adolescent and youth
8. Cohesive transparency and accountability
9. Empowerment of Civil Society organizations CSOs, Nongovernmental Organizations NGOs and local communities in developing countries

Who We Are

Hilfe Für Kinder in Not e. V. HKN/Children's Relief CR is an international non-governmental, non-profit organization with its headquarter in Hannover, Germany. CR was founded in 1986. CR focused its intervention in Africa, Middle East and Western Balkans. Children's Relief operates independently, it's not politically, none racially and none religiously driven.



Strategic Framework

Under the platform of the UN convention and the European Union agreements on the rights of protection, education, access to health and social inclusion for every child, CR strife to lobby, advocate and achieve successful implementation process of its activities.



Our Focus Target Priorities

CR is advocating and lobbying with families of disabled children and adolescent for inclusive societies, access to public schools, public facilities and equal opportunities for jobs and employment of youth with disabilities. Promoting and emphasizing the need for integration and interethnic, religion communities.

CR provides direct support to low income or unemployed single parents' primarily young mothers to learn IT and office skills, handicrafts, husbandry and farming as well provision of goods to start up small bossiness. Children's Relief providing capacity building implementing projects partnership with local NGOs and civil society lobby and advocacy groups.

CR is therefore conducts meticulous needs assessment of a potential project area, to determine the appropriate intervention necessary. Children's Relief signs agreements with ministries of Education, Health, Social welfare and labor to ensure that the activities carried out are recognized and will be carried over in the future of the respective countries.



What we want to Achieve

CR is pursuing five goals with one mission:

1. Make Education Possible for children, boys and girls free of discrimination of disabled children, ethnic and religion minorities and the poor accessible in public schools.

2. Long-term services, supporting community based structures of institutions and public agencies to provide free access to justice, counseling, social welfare and income generating opportunities to our focus target groups

3. Alleviating poverty for children and adolescent, victims of war or natural disasters, by public awareness, offering direct support and income generation opportunities for their families

4. Youth empowerment, developing and implementing projects, which facilitate and create opportunities of sustainable and long-term solutions with local CSOs and NGOs.

5. Fighting to end child abuse, trafficking and domestic violence, supports the rights to protection of child and teenage girls' victims of gender based sexual abuse, domestic violence and trafficking.

All planned activities will be discussed and co-ordinated with stakeholders (community leaders, local CSOs, local and international agencies and authorities as well directly with target groups). CR conducts international and European Union standard tender documentation and proceedings on bids for project implementations. If available, all recruitment of employment, procurements, of goods as well selection of qualified companies is made locally to benefit the community and the local markets.





Funding Sources

Children's Relief relies fully in first place to donations and contributions of the German's generous society to fund its activities.

In the past some of CR projects are funded as well by the United Nations (UNHCR), the European Commission (EC), the European Commission Humanitarian Office (ECHO), the German Ministry of Foreign Affairs (AA) and the Federal State of Lower Saxony (Niedersachsen). CR in Western Balkans implements its activities in partnership and co/funding including grants from the Netherlands, United States of America, and the Canadian embassies.



Goals and Objectives

CR has extensive experience and expertise to deliver;

1. Workshops, seminars and platforms to debate possible and inclusive education, working with local authorities and community leaders, building capacities, as well reconstruction and revitalization of schools. Advocating and lobbying for inclusive education for all children
2. support institutions which provide long-term services, such as community premises for training and counseling children with special needs and their parents
3. Youth empowerment activities through building capacities of youth CSOs, NGOs and to centers for vocational training and learning job skills.
4. Work to improve children and adolescent in orphanage homes and correctional homes and kindergartens.
5. Provide support and build capacities of public structures for access to free legal aid, social welfare and income generation with CSOs and NGOs that focused to support young mothers and teenage girls' victims of gender based sexual abuse, domestic violence or trafficking.
